### **Felony Pretrial Conference for Yuba City Woman Accused of Killing 13-Year-Old Alec Flores Takes Place Monday; New Motion Filed**

**Yuba City, CA, Sept. 23, 2020** – The pretrial hearing for Constance N. Addison is scheduled to take place at the Sutter County Superior Courthouse located at 1175 Civic Center Blvd in Yuba City on Monday, September 28, 2020 at 1:30 p.m. The trial date is set for Tuesday, January 5, 2021.

Addison is accused of killing 13-year-old Alec Flores while driving intoxicated the morning of October 7, 2019. Flores was walking to Franklin Elementary School around 8:00 a.m. when he was fatally struck by a vehicle, allegedly driven by Addison. She also had her children in the car.

She is charged with: PC187(a)- F-Murder, PC191.5(a)- F-Gross Vehicular Manslaughter While Intoxicated, VC20001(b)(1)- F-Hit & Run Resulting in Injury; and PC273a(b)- M-Child Endangering- Cruelty to Child.

The defendant has filed a motion to dismiss information and an additional hearing will take place on Friday, October 2 at 9 a.m. regarding that matter. Addison will move for an order to set aside one count; the alleged violation of Penal Code Section 187 (F-Murder) as charged in the Information.
