Venue Change Requested by Yuba City Woman Accused of Killing 13-Year-Old Alec Flores

Yuba City, CA, Dec. 8, 2020 – The defendant in the People of the State of California vs. Addison, Constance Nicole has filed a motion to change the venue for the upcoming jury trial, currently set for Tuesday, January 5, 2021. A hearing for this motion has been scheduled to take place at the Sutter County Superior Courthouse located at 1175 Civic Center Blvd in Yuba City on Thursday, Dec. 10, 2020 at 9:00 a.m.

In a second motion, the defendant has requested the return of personal property, referring to her driver's license.

Addison is accused of killing 13-year-old Alec Flores while driving intoxicated the morning of October 7, 2019. Flores was walking to Franklin Elementary School around 8:00 a.m. when he was fatally struck by a vehicle, allegedly driven by Addison. She also had her children in the car.

She is charged with: PC187(a)- F-Murder, PC191.5(a)- F-Gross Vehicular Manslaughter While Intoxicated, VC20001(b)(1)- F-Hit & Run Resulting in Injury; and PC273a(b)- M-Child Endangering- Cruelty to Child.

At the most recent hearing, Oct. 2, the defendant moved to set aside the alleged violation of Penal Code Section 187 (F-Murder) as charged in the Information. The motion was denied.
