### **Sentencing for Woman Found Guilty of Murdering 13-Year-Old Alec Flores While Driving Intoxicated Takes Place on Friday**

#### ***Motion for a New Trial Will Also Be Heard***

**Yuba City, CA, Sept. 29, 2021** – The sentencing for Constance Nicole Addison will take place on Friday, October 1 at 1:30 p.m. at the [Sutter County Superior Courthouse](#), located at 1175 Civic Center Blvd. Yuba City, CA 95993.

Addison fatally struck 13-year-old Alec Flores while driving intoxicated with her children in the car the morning of October 7, 2019. Flores was walking to Franklin Elementary School.

A two-week trial was held in Butte County and the jury found Addison guilty on all charges: PC187(a)- F-Murder, PC191.5(a)- F-Gross Vehicular Manslaughter While Intoxicated, VC20001(b)(1)- F-Hit & Run Resulting in Injury; and PC273a(b)- M-Child Endangering- Cruelty to Child.

A motion for a new trial has been filed by Addison’s attorney. It is scheduled to be heard along with sentencing on Friday.
