Trial Readiness Conference for Yuba City Woman Accused of Killing 13-Year-Old Alec Flores Scheduled for Friday

Yuba City, CA, July 21, 2021 – A trial readiness conference for Constance N. Addison is scheduled to take place at the Sutter County Superior Courthouse located at 1175 Civic Center Blvd in Yuba City on Friday, July 23 at 9:00 a.m. A motions in limine hearing to review the evidence that will be allowed in the trial will also take place at this time. The trial date is currently scheduled to begin in Butte County on August 16.

Another hearing is scheduled for Friday, August 13 at 8:30 a.m. at the [Butte County Superior Court House](#) at which time the court will confirm that Butte County will be able to hold the jury trial beginning on August 16.

Addison is accused of killing 13-year-old Alec Flores while driving intoxicated the morning of October 7, 2019. Flores was walking to Franklin Elementary School around 8:00 a.m. when he was fatally struck by a vehicle, allegedly driven by Addison. She also had her children in the car.

She is charged with: PC187(a)- F-Murder, PC191.5(a)- F-Gross Vehicular Manslaughter While Intoxicated, VC20001(b)(1)- F-Hit & Run Resulting in Injury; and PC273a(b)- M-Child Endangering- Cruelty to Child.
